Road crossing



Railway platform edge

- Tactile and visual device intended for alerting blind and partially sighted people to imminent dangers on their way like:
 - Road crossing
 - Railway platform edge
 - Bus stop
 - Stairs...



- Made of **fiber-reinforced methacrylate resin**, the tile is:
 - Extremely flexible
 - Does not turn yellow with UV light
 - Extremely tear-resistant
 - Easy to install
 - Extraordinarily anti-slip (even wet)
 - and hard to get dirty.

■ **Bonding system:**

Recommended for outdoor and indoor use on surface media which are:

Coated:

The surface should be clean, dry and free of non-adherent material (dust, grit, grease, oil, etc.). New coatings should be at least 1 month old and be free of bleeding dye for their application.

Concrete:

After making sure that the surface is clean, dry and free of non-adherent material (dust, grit, grease, oil, etc.). For new screed let dry for at least 3 weeks.

1 - Blast it or diamond grind it.

2 - Apply a layer of **MTA PRIMER (methacrylate Ref. 4228)** with a roller (about 400g / m²).

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Stages for applying the tile:

- 1) **Establish** and define the application area on your surface media with masking.
- 2) **Mix** the two components of the **MTA glue** (methacrylate ref 4229), using an electric mixer.
- 3) **Apply** the mixture with a notched trowel (B15 Ref. 94919 with teeth 4 mm wide by 2.5 mm high).
 For more open surfaces it is advisable to use a trowel (with teeth 7 mm wide by 5 mm high) in the amount of:
 - For the "EXTELINE" TACTILE TILE 42 x 84: **1 to 3 kg/tile depending on the surface media.**
 Pass the mixture about 5 mm over your masking.
- 4) **Place** immediately the "EXTELINE" TACTILE TILE on the glue.
 Apply some light pressure to avoid air bubbles and to spread glue to edges and corners.
- 5) **Remove** the masking and wait for it to fully harden before allowing pedestrian traffic.
